

Dawlish College PE kit Policy

Things that your son/daughter needs to remember when coming to PE lessons:

- Kit must always be brought into college on PE timetabled days
- PE kit remains the responsibility of the pupil
- ALL jewellery must be removed for all PE lessons. Newly pierced ears must be covered for the initial 6-week period and then removed after this time.
- Unless physically unable to participate in the lesson, students will be expected to change into full PE kit and take an active part in the lesson
- If a student is physically unable to participate in his/her lesson over a short period of time, a letter/email to the staff member must be sent from home detailing the issue preventing participation prior to the lesson
- Any long-term issues preventing participation may require a doctor's note

Sanctions for Incorrect kit and No kit:

1st Incorrect Kit/ No kit will be marked in the register and the student will be given a warning. A letter sent home to parents/carers.

2nd Incorrect Kit/ No kit will be marked in the register, the student will be spoken to and will go to the unit for both breaks one and two of that day or equivalent over two days. A letter will be sent home to parents/carers.

3rd Incorrect Kit/No kit will be marked in the register, the student will be spoken to and will go to the unit for both breaks one and two of that day or equivalent over two days. The teacher will contact home and explain that the student will now be on PE report for a 2-week cycle.

| DC logoed hoodie | Optional (No non DC logoed hoodies allowed) |
| Trainers or astro trainers (any colour or brand, must be non-marking, no high tops or canvas pumps) | Compulsory |
| *Mouth guard (for hockey/rugby) | Compulsory |
| Shin pads ((for hockey/football/rugby) | Compulsory |
| Hair tie | Compulsory |

Mouth Guards

We would like to remind parents that as per Dawlish Colleges PE kit requirements, we strongly recommend the use of gum shields for contact sports such as rugby and hockey. Gum shields help to protect teeth against damage. These can be purchased from ParentMail.

If a pupil is unable to wear a gum shield, then parents are asked to write a signed note or send an email to the staff member, as to whether or not you give your consent for them to participate in contact sports. If this consent is not given, then alternative arrangements for PE provision will be made for those times when these activities are running.

Pupils who do not wear gum shields and do not have parental consent to play without one, will be limited as to which sporting practices and activities, they can participate in.

Gum shields for students who have braces can be purchased specifically online.
