

## Home Learning Expectations

Home learning is essential in ensuring the best possible outcomes for young people. Our structured approach and use of adaptive technologies gives students every possible opportunity to maximise their learning and therefore their knowledge and understanding so that they can fulfil their potential.

Home learning will be set as per the schedule below. The most important things for parents to be aware of to support their child in completing their assignments are as follows:

- All home learning will be set on epraise. If you do not have an account and would like support in setting one up please contact [sbanks@dawlish.devon.sch.uk](mailto:sbanks@dawlish.devon.sch.uk)
- The majority of tasks will be assignments set within an interactive platform called Seneca. Students will have set up their accounts in school using their college username and password so all they will need to do is click on the link in epraise and sign in with those details.
- Maths will be set using a different platform: Sparx.
- The main objective is to get the **highest score possible** so we absolutely expect students to complete each assignment more than once. Their teacher will be able to see their lowest score, highest score, average score, number of attempts and so on. **It is not about getting the task done but actually increasing their knowledge and understanding by completing it multiple times (each time it will be slightly different) filling the gaps in their knowledge and understanding as they go.**
- Home learning assignments will often be based on the topics taught previously. This will give all students an important opportunity to revisit that knowledge and build on what they learnt the first-time round. This is known as 'retrieval practice' and it is vital in establishing long term retention of knowledge and securing deeper understanding.
